It is a great honor to all of us that the new primary school in Marsaskala will be officially inaugurated next Wednesday. Overall, during the past fifteen months a number of achievements were recorded. Sixty VET Labs were completed in eight schools and other projects around Malta and Gozo were also undertaken. Maintenance and refurbishments in various schools were completed and the school grounds are now much safer than they were previously. Of course there is more work to be done.

The management of FTS has strengthened and the design of the BM Projects are now complete and ready to be tendered out, namely; The School hall in St. Lucia; The school extension of Rabat Malta; The Primary School extension in Rabat Gozo; San Miguel in Bulebel; VET Labs in Gozo and the VET labs and refurbishment of Blocks in Zejtun and Mriehel. The Msida Primary School design is at an advanced stage, waiting for the direction of the PA. Of course there are more designs ready but not worth mentioning here.

However, after fifteen months as Chief Executive Officer in charge of FTS, I am now feeling that my energy and drive have started to subside. Therefore for the good of FTS and the government, I wish to tender my resignation to allow the opportunity for others to take the role of the CEO.

By virtue, my last day as CEO of FTS is the 15th March, 2019.

I do not exclude the possibility to work with MEDE or any other entity in future where the role is less demanding and less onerous to task.

Let me take the opportunity to thank you for your trust in me, and look forward to hopefully get another chance to serve you again in the near future.
